The following is a review of items discussed at the meeting:

1. K. Waller re-capped the history of discussions and decision making which produced the current POR. Each bracket of the POR was presented. District-wide changes to the POR as well as those changes which were unique to Voris were identified.
2. K. Waller talked briefly about the site and the scheme which was favored by most of the group. Some in the group had questions about site safety, vehicular circulation and how playgrounds would be utilized with two schools on the same site. It was noted that staggering of the schools schedules can ease traffic congestion as well as allow the playground to be easily shared by both facilities.
3. S. Taylor provided an update on discussions between APS and the YMCA regarding a potential partnership. Possible benefits could include an enlarged or upgraded gymnasium. The exact nature of the relationship between YMCA and APS and how it impacts the project will be determined in future discussions.
4. K. Waller shared with the group that the meeting schedule will come to a rest until meetings for Schematic Design are held. Persons who have attended the Programming meetings will be contacted when meetings are scheduled to resume.
