The following is a brief review of items discussed at the meeting.

- Principal Blondheim introduced all participants and gave a general introduction for the program.
- J. Peterson gave a general overview of the graphic program of requirements for the new 500 student Hatton Community Learning Center.
  - Noted that the enrollment has been modified from 450 to 500; noted that the planned classroom capacity is 18 students for grades K-2 and 22 students for grades 3-5.
  - Noted reducing classroom enrollment from 900 sq. ft. to approximately 880 sq. ft. in order to increase the size of the Media Center for a possible Little Theatre.
  - Revised size of ISS from 900 sq. ft. to 1200 sq. ft.



- Increased size of Speech from 150 sq. ft. to 200 sq. ft.
- Increased Special Education CD/SLD from three to four units.
- Question about the toilet room needing to be adjacent to special ed.
- Added additional Title 1 room (200 sq. ft.).
- Building will increase by 4,800 sq. ft.; add circulation, lobby, and restrooms.
- J. Peterson gave a brief review of the aerial site photographs.
  - Will start developing site options.
  - Schematic design will develop site, floor plan, and elevation options.
  - This will be a demolition and re-build program; students will be relocated to Hyre.
    - Other options are 400 West Market Street or Goodyear; timeline is fall 2011.
  - Soil studies will be conducted after school lets out to determine adequacy if abandoned mining activity exists.
  - Reviewed future phases of Design Development and Construction Documents. In total, the design process encompasses approximately 12 months.
  - Abatement/Demolition/New Construction will take approximately 2 years. Current schedule is for occupancy fall of 2013.
  - G. Reyna requested email addresses to be able to contact RUS committee members during the summer to notify of meetings.
  - Next meeting: TBD (approximately 3 weeks).
